

The town of Guadalest is one of the most picturesque settlements near Benidorm and it provides an essential excursion destination for people visiting the city.

Altea

Another place you simply must visit when visiting Benidorm is Altea. This town is located very close to Benidorm and it offers a combination of extremely special natural and cultural resources. Its historic centre is delightful.

You can also enjoy its rocky beaches with their clear waters, wander the pretty streets of its old quarter and visit its church with its recognisable blue cupolas.

To visit Altea from Benidorm, we recommend using the Benidorm-Altea tram line as the journey only takes 11 minutes.





Algar Waterfalls

Only at 20 km from Benidorm and 3 km from the town center of Callosa d'en Sarrià, you can find this incomparable natural setting.

The route consists of a circuit of 1.5 km in length along the river Algar.



Alicante

The city of Alicante is one of the most popular choices for a day out among travellers staying in Benidorm. Alicante, as the capital of the province, has all the essential services you could need in a city.

Furthermore, Alicante has a large number of beaches as well as natural and cultural resources you can explore, including Santa Barbara Castle.

To enjoy an excursion to Alicante from Benidorm, you can take line 1 (L1) on the tram and you'll be in Alicante in approximately 76 minutes. You could also take the bus, which takes around an hour to reach Alicante.





Calpe

Calpe is a special place due to its unique crags and picturesque town setting, in addition to the chance to enjoy enchanting beaches. It is only 25 kilometres from Benidorm.

The bus to this city will take around 2 hours.

2 | Section of beautiful beaches and coves for relaxation

It has a length of 120 meters of beautiful fine sand and calm waters. And as it is sheltered on both sides, it is the perfect place for enthusiastic divers.



Mal Pas Beach

Mal Pas Beach is located between Poniente Beach and Levante Beach. Just in front of this beach you can make out Benidorm Island among its excellent views.

We recommend you visit this

beach at nightfall as the sunsets you can see from this beach are spectacular.

Mal Pas Beach enjoys a great location as it is very central. It is just an 11-minute bike ride from Hotel Don Pancho.



Tio Ximo Cove

Tio Ximo Cove is a small, picturesque cove nestled between two cliffs at the end of Levante Beach. Its location offers bathers plenty of privacy.

This cove is famous among locals due to its stunning sea beds, which are ideal for diving thanks to clear waters.

This is one of the most recommended beaches in Benidorm!



Almadraba

Almadraba is a perfect beach if you are looking to enjoy the peace and quiet of the sea, given that its waters are very calm, with almost no waves and a turquoise hue.

Despite being a mixed beach of both sand and rocks, it has a sunbed service allowing you to easily relax.

As it is near the city, access to this small oasis is rather simple.



Albir Beach

Located 7 kilometres from Benidorm, in Alfaz del Pí, Albir Beach is a rocky beach famous for its marine fauna.

Both the village of Alfaz del Pí and its beach are surrounded by the Sierra Helada Natural Park as well as by the warm Mediterranean atmosphere. This area has various charming coves with crystal clear waters.

If you would like to discover a charming beach where you can go diving, the walk here is worth the effort!





Mascarat Cove

Although this cove is not exactly in Benidorm, due to its proximity and beauty, we had to include it.

Only 20 minutes from Benidorm, in Altea and within the Sierra Helada natural park, you will find this cove surrounded by small cliffs.

This beach of soft pebbles has

all the comforts you need to enjoy a perfect bath, such as parking, a beach bar, a restaurant and a lifeguard.

If you want to practice snorkelling in addition to refreshing yourself, you will find a surprising sea bed full of corals and colourful fish, under its crystal-clear waters. Find out for yourself!

Finestrat Cove

Although Finestrat Cove isn't exactly in Benidorm, it's worth a visit. It is only 10 minutes from the centre of Benidorm, this cove is next to Poniente Beach, almost in the municipality of the same name, Finestrat.

You can get to this cove via a short bus, car or taxi ride.

It is surrounded by low mountains and is usually very quiet, meaning you can escape from the bustling city.



Cala del Metge

If you want to swim in a cove in Benidorm practically untouched, you have to visit the Cala del Metge in Albir. Located at the entrance to Sierra Helada Natural Park, under its cliffs, it is perfect for refreshing yourself.

Discover under its transparent waters, the beautiful sea beds that characterise the whole area close to the Park.

Don't miss it!

Bol Nou

This lovely cove although it is not located in Benidorm, but in Villajoyosa, it in only 15 minutes from the city.

It has incredible views to the reddish cliffs surrounding it, crystal clear waters and beautiful sunsets.

In spite of being a cove where you can enjoy a quiet bath, it has services such as a lifeguard and a beach bar.



Roda de Altea Beach

Finally, Roda de Altea Beach is worth a mention. If you decide to go on an excursion to the picture-perfect town of Altea, which is one of the most beautiful in Spain, make

sure you go for a swim here. In addition to clear waters, you will find a wide selection of gastronomy options you can enjoy after a day at the beach.

3 | Discover the magic of Benidorm





Balcón del Mediterráneo

One of the wonders of the city is Punta Canfalí. It is in this great rock, which separates the two great beaches of Benidorm, Levante and Poniente, where the emblematic Castle of Benidorm was located. Today only some of the remains of its walls can be seen. Converted into a viewpoint, it is known as the "Balcón del Mediterráneo".

From this viewpoint, the views that you will be able to observe are magnificent. On one side the Levante beach,

on the other the Poniente beach. And in front, the immensity of the sea, and the island of Benidorm in the distance.

Viewpoint of the Cross

This place will allow you to discover the magnificent Mediterranean flora and fauna and disconnect from the hustle and bustle of the city.

Another of the most picturesque viewpoints in the city is the “Cruz de Benidorm”, from where you can enjoy the best panoramic views of the city. This is one of the most recommended places to visit in Benidorm if you like nature.

You can discover this beautiful place during a day of hiking. Or if you prefer, you can also get there by car. And although the views are spectacular at any time of day, it’s the perfect place to enjoy Benidorm’s wonderful late afternoon sunsets. We recommend that you dedicate one to enjoy this spectacle.



Benidorm Island

One of the most special excursions you can do in Benidorm is to sail to its island. A great option to enjoy a special day during your holidays in Benidorm.

You will be able to board any of the boats that depart frequently to the island. Once there you will only have to let yourself be surprised by its nature.

Since most boats have underwater vision, you won't miss any of the beauty of the Mediterranean!





Sierra Helada

One of the most impressive Natural Parks on the Costa Blanca is the Sierra Helada. If you like nature and want to go hiking, this is your activity!

A very good route option would be to start at the Cruz de Benidorm viewpoint and take a walk along the cliffs of this beautiful mountain range and enjoy unparalleled views of the Mediterranean and the city. Don't worry because there is a sign at the beginning of the route, it is very well marked and explained.

Don't forget the camera, because the views are breathtaking!

Water parks

Benidorm has two water parks, Aqua Natura and Aqualandia open in season.

Aqua Natura is an aquatic park of 40000 square meters ideal for a day of fun and relaxation in the water and can be combined with Terra Natura (the animal park).

Aqualandia, on the other hand, has more intense aquatic attractions, gardens with typical vegetation of the area and a whole series of additional services.

Theme parks



Benidorm has several fun parks with something to do for all ages. If you are looking for adrenaline in its purest form, you should visit the Terra Mítica theme park. If, on the other hand, you prefer a quiet place and like nature more, you can't miss the Terra Natura and Mundomar parks.

Terra Natura concentrates more than two hundred different species from Africa, Asia and Europe. MundoMar, on the other hand, has different species of reptiles, birds and mammals and the possibility of living experiences such as swimming with sea lions or having an encounter with dolphins.

Tourist Train

A fun way to get to know Benidorm is the tourist train.

It has two different routes, narrated with audio-guide, one in the Poniente area and the other in the Levante area.

The train runs through the best of Benidorm, its beaches and its most representative buildings. For example, in the Levante area the train runs along the Avenida del Mediterráneo and the viewpoints of Sierra Helada. The journey takes approximately 45 minutes. You can't miss it!



Panoramic Bus

Benidorm has two scenic bus routes that allow knowing the town and its immediate surroundings (Altea, Albir and Cala de Finestrat).

The double-decker buses on line 30 begin their journey in Rincón de Loix and pass through Av Mediterráneo, Centro, Parque de Elche and Paseo de

Poniente to reach Cala de Finestrat. Line 31 also departs from Rincón de Loix and goes on to the beaches of Albir and Altea.

In addition, you can complete your visit with the line 16 that takes to Guadalest or with the line 18 that brings you to the Fuentes del Algar. You can take both lines at various stops in Benidorm (in the west - centre or east zones).

Benidorm Circus

In the Benidorm Circus you will enjoy a show in which you will experience a tour of the entire history of the circus world from 1930 to the present day, through the eyes of a child growing up to become a master of ceremonies. Approximate duration of 2 hours.



Benidorm Palace



It is an emblematic place of the Mediterranean coast, which has welcomed internationally renowned artists of the height of Julio Iglesias, Rudolf Nureyev, Lola Flores, Alejandro Sanz, and many more.

In the Benidorm Palace you will enjoy shows of vedettes, dances, magic, humour, and many other different performances.

Shows on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays with option to book dinner as well.

Basque Zone for tapas

These are streets located in the historic center of the city where you will find a very interesting gastronomic offer centered on tapas and pintxos. A great option for a snack or a delicious aperitif before returning to dinner at the hotel.

The most important streets and squares to visit are: Calle de Santo Domingo, Calle José Martínez Oriola and Plaza de la Constitución.



Shopping in Benidorm

If you prefer to go for a walk around the city and get some souvenirs for back home, we invite you to walk through the streets of Benidorm crowded with shops.

The Avenida del Mediterráneo, parallel to the Levante beach,

is a perfect area for shopping in Benidorm.

You can also visit one of its numerous and eye-catching markets. The most popular is Rincón de Lloix, where you can find food as well as clothes and toys, you will be surprised by its variety!



Nightlife

If there's one thing Benidorm is known for, it's its nightlife. Its diversity of pubs, discos and bars for all tastes will make you enjoy an unforgettable night.

The Levante beach is home to a large number of premises for all types of travellers. The British area is located in Rincón de Lloix where there are many establishments focused on the British public. If your style is more lively, you can also find many places where you can enjoy a more casual atmosphere. On the other hand, if you are looking for quieter plans, the city is also full of small bars where you can sit and have a drink.
